Instructions

Enter your Zip Code and hit Search to find a class near you

On the next page, you can scroll through the all the class options and use the tools on the left side bar to refine your search (i.e. – search for classes within 5 miles of your zip code, type of class, day of the week, etc)

When you find a class option and location you like, click on View Details

On the next page you'll see the Zumba studio's phone number. Call them to set up your NCCC Chapter Zumba Event!

Questions to Ask the Zumba Studio

- (1) Will the studio donate the space and instructor's time or negotiate a discounted price to help ensure fundraising is profitable?
- (2) If your group is going to be big, ask if the studio can have more than one instructor, so that everyone can see and follow along
- (3) Does the studio allow children? Minimum age restrictions?
- (4) Does the studio have amenities? (i.e. – lockers, showers, snack bar)
- (5) On the Zumba.com site there is a tab to click on to see a list of charity events. How do you get your event listed?
- (6) What sort of event-related tabling can you set up at the studio during your event? (i.e. – distribution on NCCC education literature, silent auction, raffles, selling of NCCC branded items, solicitation of NCCC donations, registration table)
